Henri Fayol explains management as a process of forecast followed by planning, organisation, command, coordination and control of activities of others. In simpler terms, management refers to proper organisation and delegation of work along with ensuring its completion. Vitally, this simple concept is the basis for Fayol ' s principle of management. Notably, be it a corporate set up or a simple business enterprise, efficient management is vital to ensure smooth functioning, which in turn ...

Fayol also identified five central elements of the management process: planning, organizing, command, coordination and control. These were his Fayolian functions of management. Fayol ' s principles have been criticised for promoting an unrealisable and often unattainable approach to management, and not being applicable in certain situations.

He was the first theorist to define the functions of management in his book " General and Industrial Management " in the year 1916. Centralisation. In a centralised organisation power is held by head office or a small number of managers, whilst decentralised organisations allow departments and individuals to make decisions. Fayol believes that its important to have a balance between centralisation and decentralisation; the appropriate level of centralisation will depend on the organisation structure and objectives.
